Village Board Meeting Minutes

This meeting was conducted via telephone conference, due to the pandemic. President Darrell Jett opened the meeting at 10:03 am.

Roll Call Completed by Clerk/Treasurer Sheryl Reynolds:

- The financial review for July has been completed satisfactorily.


Old Business: None
