ORDINANCE NUMBER 16-07

AN ORDINANCE REVISING PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 38, SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE II- RATES & REGULATIONS; SECTION 38-2-1-1 PERTAINING TO BILLING; UTILITY SHUT-OFF; HEARING WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLSON.

This ordinance specifically applies to any/all water customers billed by the Village of Donnellson.

- All bills for utility services shall be due and payable upon presentation. If a bill is not paid within **fifteen (15) days**, a penalty equal to **ten percent (10%)** of the amount due on said bill shall be added thereto. This penalty shall be in addition to the charges heretofore established for the utility services.
- Any customer who fails to pay the utility bills within **twenty-six** (26) days of presentation shall have the utility services disconnected.
- The Customer is afforded an opportunity for a hearing.
- All bills for utility services will include due date, late fee, and last day acceptable prior to shut-off.
